



Poster session guidelines

Available area:

- **1000 x 1060 mm** (39 x 41")

Printed poster format:

- **Smaller or equal** to standard **A1 format** (**A0 is too large!!!!**), or custom size, within limits. A1 format means : 594x 841 mm or 23.39 x 33 inch

Poster should include

- paper title and authors at the top of the poster, affiliation, e-mail address of the corresponding author for contact
- a brief introduction, goals, experimental detail, conclusions, and references (make sure this information is presented in a logical and clear sequence)
- explanations for graphs, pictures, and tables
- title of the conference, date, location (not compulsory)

Suggested font sizes:

- 72 pts. for title
- 36 pts. for authors
- 20 pts. double-spaced text
- Recommended reading distance: min. 2-3 m (6-10 ft.)

Poster session

- Presenter is required to mount his poster/posters/ at the indicated Reference NB (as indicated in the programme) and stand by the poster during the scheduled poster session to answer questions from attendees and reviewers. Business cards and flyers can be added in the poster area.
- Presenters must remove their posters immediately after the poster session ending.
- Posters not removed will be considered unwanted and will be discarded.

Please keep in mind and pay attention that for the poster session, series of diplomas, prizes and mentions are offered: for best content, best presentation, best visual outfit, thematic approach, best fit to the conference scope, etc.
